It was only later that I recognised the connection to the Buddha's notion of 'purposelessness'. In both cases, it is about going into an experience, untethered to our fears, our anxieties, our self-consciousness, our needs to be and to do. The Village Game opens up a discussion that is both emotional and analytical, mourning loss and violation. Pandemic has revealed to us that the 'normal' to which we think we want to return has not worked for the vast majority of human beings. We have been pulling back the veil and have begun to interrogate systems of oppressions as anti-human and in need of re-imagining to the point overturning.
